
Cervical cancer can be prevented!

In Japan, 10,000 people get cervical cancer every year, and about 3,000 people die from it.

Approximately 1,000 people a year lose their uterus due to treatment by the time they reach their 30s.


You can receive the HPV vaccination at public expense (free of charge)!
